

PRE-ADMISSION COURSEWORK AUDIT

Automating the admissions requirements process

The Pre-Admission Coursework Audit feature provides the ability to run an audit of a candidate's coursework prior to being admitted into a degree program. EMPOWER will evaluate a candidate's earlier coursework from other schools in order to determine whether admissions requirements have been met using established criteria. This type of evaluation is done by schools where candidates must complete some college level credits before acceptance into the desired program.

Once the degree audit requirements are set up for the pre-admissions degree and the courses taken at other schools have been entered, a pre-admissions audit can be initiated. The audit will compare each course entered on the Transfer Credit screen from other schools against the degree audit requirements. A detailed degree audit report will be produced with a "yes" or "no" answer for meeting the overall requirements and the detail on which courses have or have not met requirements.

The Pre-Admission Coursework Audit provides an automated method of determining whether admissions requirements have been met. It also provides documentation of the requirements that have been met as well as those that still need to be met by the applicant. Not only will applicants benefit from this functionality, but also admissions directors, counselors and decision makers.
