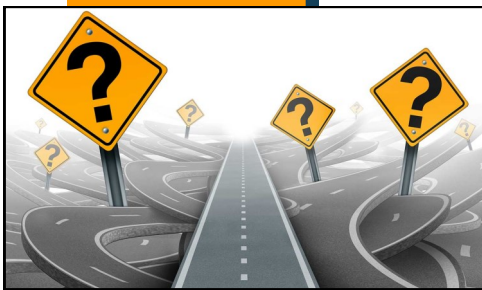


PLAN OF STUDY

Creating an academic roadmap

Plan of Study makes it possible to plot out a student's enrollments each term, showing exactly which classes to take and when. Student plans can be built from scratch or created from editable templates based on degree and major. In addition, the forecast tool displays how many students need to take a course in any given term, making it easier to plan future course offerings.

Templates are created for each major and degree combination and then courses are added to a plan and grouped by term sequence. Advisors or students are then able to develop a customized plan, adding or removing classes as needed and designating specific terms to the sequence. They can also view progress in the plan to see which classes have been taken and when, what grade was received, etc. As an option, a student's online registration can be restricted so they can only register for classes that are within their plan.



Students, advisors and registrars all benefit from the Plan of Study feature. Students are able to see a clear path to their degree and their progress towards it, helping them stay on track, plan ahead and graduate on time. Advisors can provide students with a clear picture of what they need to do to finish their degree as well as help students complete their degree on time using tools that can lock plans and restrict registration. Registrars can use the forecast feature to anticipate course offerings that will meet students' needs.
